REGULAR CITY MEETINGMINUTES

DECEMBER 2, 2008 7:00 PM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners McDowell, Shelburne, Vowels, and Wise. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, Police Chief Chappell, and City Clerk Batliner. Guest: Commissioner -Elect Cummins.

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton reminded the Commission of the Christmas Parade Saturday December 6 in Shelbyville.
