

**CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE
REGULAR CITY MEETING MINUTES
CITY COMMISSION ROOM
NOVEMBER 19, 2008 8:30 AM**

Present: Mayor Eden, Commissioners McDowell, Shelburne, Vowels and Wise. City Attorney Hays was in attendance as legal council, City Administrator Eaton, Police Chief Chappell, Public Works Director Romine, and City Clerk Batliner. Guests: Jean Glore/Optimist Club.

Mayor Eden called the meeting to order at 8:32 am.

Mayor Eden recognized Jean Glore with the Optimist Club. Ms. Glore presented information on forming an Optimist Club in Simpsonville. The Commission agreed to allow the Club to use the Community room for their meetings.

Mayor Eden presented the minutes from November 4, 2008 regular meeting for approval and everyone was furnished a copy. **Commissioner Wise made the motion to accept the minutes as presented. Commissioner Vowels seconded. Motion carried unanimously.**

Mayor Eden recognized the City Administrator's Report: City Administrator Eaton advised the RFP deadline will be Friday, November 21, 2008.

Mayor Eden recognized the Police Department's Report: Police Chief Chappell reported a street light out on Old Veechdale and Oak Street.

Mayor Eden recognized the Public Works Department's Report: Public Works Director Romine advised he is working with the county to provide the City with salt brine. He also addressed the Cardinal Club and Lincoln Foundation projects are progressing. Public Works Director Romine advised someone had dump chemicals into the sewer this past weekend; the proper officials have been contacted.

Mayor Eden recognized the Parks Report: Absent.

Mayor Eden recognized the City Clerk's Report: City Clerk Batliner advised property taxes will be due December 1, 2008. City Clerk Batliner also advised the City of Sacramento will be doing a site visit in the near future.

Commissioner McDowell made the motion to adjourn. Commissioner Wise seconded. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting concluded approximately 9:00am.
