

Summary of Simpsonville Ordinance No. 2009-005


Simpsonville City Ordinance No. 2009-005 establishes requirements and regulations for adult entertainment establishments within the city of Simpsonville. Section one includes the preamble which discusses the city effort to protect its citizens while preserving the right of free speech granted by the U.S. and KY Constitutions. Section two, lists the city's rationale for enacting the ordinance. Section three contains definitions used in the ordinance. Section four explicates the process of obtaining a license to operate an adult entertainment establishment. Section five contains the fees which must be paid to the city in order to operate an adult entertainment establishment. Section six involves the inspections required of the establishment. Section seven explains the expiration and renewal of the license. Sections eight and nine set out rules for suspension and revocation of the license. Section ten establishes guidelines for an establishment to appeal any part of the licensing process through a hearing. Section eleven prevents the license from being transferred between establishments. Section twelve sets out acceptable hours of operation. Section thirteen regulates what activities are allowed on the premises. Section fourteen prohibits loitering. Section fifteen establishes the methods for enforcing the ordinance and penalties for violating the ordinance. Section sixteen allows for existing adult entertainment businesses to obtain the appropriate licensing to stay in operation. Section seventeen covers prohibited conduct. Section eighteen and nineteen makes the owner of the business responsible for the acts of his employees and grants the proposed establishment a license in the event the city does not meet its deadline to accept or reject their license application. Section twenty and twenty-one allows the ordinance to be severable and inoperable if in conflict with the Simpsonville Code of Ordinances. Section twenty-two involves location restrictions. Section twenty-three gives the ordinances' effective date.

This Ordinance was read the second time and passed unanimously on May 20, 2009.
